DESCRIPTION OF LICENSES

Harvester Registration ALL COMMERCIAL HARVESTERS MUST BE REGISTERED. This registration is nontransferable. (Exempt from registration: fishing guides, dealers and seafood landing license). Fishing Guide Allows licensee to provide services as a fishing guide in the tidal waters of Maryland, FGR or FGN including the Atlantic Ocean within state waters A Resident Fishing Guide may not be changed to a Nonresident Fishing Guide. * Must attach a copy of current USCG Captains License Allows the use of hook & line gear to harvest finfish for sale. HLI Finfish - Hook & Line Allows the use of all legal equipment to harvest finfish for sale. Unlimited Finfish Harvester FIN Allows the use of up to 50 crab pots, trotlines, nets, dip nets, traps, pounds and scrapes to harvest Limited Crab Harvester LCC blue crabs for sale. **Must specify crabbing day off. Allows the use of up to 50 crab pots, trotlines, nets, dip nets, traps, pounds and scrapes to harvest Limited Crab Harvester **LCCM** male blue crabs only for sale. **Must specify crabbing day off. (Male only) Allows the use of up to 300 crab pots, trotlines, nets, dip nets, traps, pounds and scrapes to harvest Crab Harvester CB3 blue crabs for sale. **Must specify crabbing day off. -up to 300 pots Allows residents of Maryland the use of all legal equipment to harvest clams for sale. CLM Clam Harvester Allows residents of Maryland to harvest oysters for sale by diving, tonging, or handscraping. OYH Oyster Harvester Allows residents of Maryland the use of a dredge boat to harvest oysters for sale. ODB Oyster Dredge Boat Allows the harvest of conch, cancer crabs, turtles, or lobsters for sale. Conch, Cancer Crab, CTL Turtles & Lobster Harvester Authorizes the holder to catch for sale Chesapeake Channas in the tidal waters of the state using a Chesapeake Channa bow and arrow attached to a retrieval line or hook and line. Authorizes the holder to catch for sale Blue and Flathead Catfish in the tidal waters of the state Blue & Flathead Catfish using a finfish trotline. Finfish Trotline License Comprehensive license available to residents of Maryland, covering all authorizations Unlimited Tidal Fish **TFL** described above. If using this license as a Fishing Guide, you must attach a copy of your current USCG Captains License. An Unlimited Tidal Fish license may be permanently converted to its component authorizations described above. **Must specify crabbing day off. May employ other persons to guide fishing parties on a vessel owned by the master fishing Master Fishing Guide guide or out of a marina owned and operated by the master guide. * Must attach a copy of current USCG Captains License Allows individuals who do not have a commercial tidal fish license to catch and sell certain species **Bait Harvester** of finfish and shellfish for bait. Applicant with a 300 pot Crab Harvester License or an Unlimited Tidal Fish License may Crab Harvester CB6 increase the number of pots to 600 or 900. **Must specify crabbing day off. 600 Pot Authorization 900 Pot Authorization CB9 (Applicant must file an application and pay a fee to be placed on a waiting list). Nonresident surcharge Additional fee required for all nonresidents of Maryland. Varies by State of residence. Oyster Harvesting Additional fee required to harvest oysters. Applicant must apply in person, by appointment only, at a DNR OYS Surcharge Service Center. Visit https://dnr.maryland.gov/Pages/License-Licensing-Appointment--Information.aspx for locations. Seafood Landing License May land fish caught in out-of-state tidal waters without a harvester's license or registration. Additional fee required of all commercial harvesters and dealers. If applicant is a harvester and dealer, Marketing Surcharge the higher dealer surcharge will be applied. Tidal Fish Dealer May process, pack, resell, market or otherwise deal in fish caught in tidal waters. Harvesters must either License sell to a licensed dealer, or be a licensed dealer in order to sell their catch. The dealer license is discounted for these harvesters.

Late Fee

Annotated Code of Maryland, Natural Resources Article, §4-701(k)(7) allows the licensee to designate an individual that may use the licensee's vessel and license. The individual indicated may be changed once in the license year. The licensee is legally responsible for all activities performed by the individual whom they have designated. Indicate the individual and their DNRid number in the appropriate box on the front of this application.

DESIGNATING A BENEFICIARY

\$50 if renewed between 9/04/24 and 3/31/25. No license may be renewed after 3/31/25.

A licensee may designate a person (does not need to be a family member) as a beneficiary of the license by indicating their name and DNRid on the front of this application. If the beneficiary holds the same license type, they will have to transfer their license in order to accept the license of the deceased. Upon licensee's death, if no beneficiary is named, an authorized representative (Letter of Administration required) may indicate a person eligible for a permanent business transfer regardless of the number of seasons the deceased held a valid tidal fish license.
